Approximately18 people attended our meeting with Vectren officials as our guest speakers.

The sign-in roster was passed after the pledge. Our April 3rd minutes will be posted on the UNOE online site, www.unoevansville.org. Shannon Stiggleman, our treasurer, reported \$226.59 in our treasury. Officer Chad Diedrich provided a crime report that Mitch circulated.

Under Old Business, Sara Ann Corrigan reported the promised landscaping may be done this summer around the parking area of the SAE Fraternity. Pam Martin continues to work with the city on the status of 752 Englewood. Another city inspection is scheduled for this abandoned house. Pam and Sara Ann continue to attend city council meetings. Mitch will contact Brian Fox about the finish date for Refresh Evansville. The project nears completion, yet much remains to be done. He will mail a copy of his letter to neighborhood residents.

Chris Claybrooks, Division Supervisor for Vectren, Blake Vietin, gas engineer and another field supervisor answered questions regarding the ongoing disruption as gas and electric lines are updated in the neighborhood. Among things discussed were the extent of invasive digging required on each property to install 'smart' electric and gas line meters. Because of the age of the connector pipes, many will require replacement. The present 'box' holes on parallel streets between Lincoln and Bayard Park are needed to locate the sewer lines. They will be leveled with asphalt once the construction project is finished. Vectren is installing tall steel poles with transmission lines handling higher electrical power. Trees will need to be trimmed more when those lines are completed. If an old pole is next to a new steel pole, the old pole will be removed. If they are separate, the old pole will remain. Vectren is nearing the completion of the project in our neighborhood for 2017/2018. A map showing the next phase of the program for 2019/2020 was circulated. Flags marking the site of water, gas, electric and sewer lines are valid for 20 days and may be removed after that date.
