If you're experiencing homelessness or at risk of losing your housing, please seek assistance. Compassionate and experienced professionals across many local organizations are available to help you find or maintain your housing. Seek the help if you need it.

Before contacting any organizations, please compile the following information (if they apply to you) to determine eligibility.

- Birth certificate
- Social Security card(s)
- Drivers license or photo ID
- Proof of expenses
- Proof of income
- Police report (if victim of abuse or theft)
- Fire report (if victim of fire or other disaster)
- Child support proof (paid or paid to)
- Legal documents (child custody/court orders)
- Checking/savings accounts (if applicable)
- Disconnect notice
- Verification of residency (rent receipt, lease, water, gas/electric bill)
