

Submit all forms to UNOE, by the deadline in the packet, for processing. Then your registration form, by-laws and map will be sent electronically to the City and/or County on your behalf.



UNOE Office Manager, Joe Ballard




Joe has worked at United Neighborhoods of Evansville for nearly 2 years.
