Evansville's riverfront has something new to brag about. The Cascade at Sunrise Pump Station is now open to the public. Built as part of the Evansville Water and Sewer Utility East Wastewater Treatment Plant expansion, Sunrise Pump Station pumps clean, treated water

through the Cascade into the Ohio River. The Cascade features swings, benches and an observation deck overlooking the river with one of the best views of the Downtown Evansville Riverfront. Parking is available in the lot off Veterans Memorial Parkway next to the pump station building, and restrooms are open year-round. Visit the Cascade yourself at 1200 Waterworks Road.

## EWSU to Switch Water Disinfectant May 22 - July 10

Starting Monday, May 22, some Evansville Water and Sewer Utility (EWSU) customers may notice a slight change in the taste and odor of their tap water. The change is related to a temporary switch in the disinfectant that is used in the water treatment process to ensure the delivery of high-quality, safe drinking water to EWSU customers.

The switch to free chlorine from the regularly used disinfectant chloramine will begin on Monday, May 22, and continue until Monday, July 10. EWSU switches disinfectants twice a year. The second switchover will be from August 28 until October 16. Many water utilities use this common preventive maintenance practice to keep water mains clean and free of potentially harmful bacteria throughout the year. For more information visit www.ewsu.com.
