Mayor Terry at Traveling City Hall & UNOE Meeting

Evansville Mayor Stephanie Terry spoke about Neighborhoods and the need to get involved at the UNOE General Membership meeting on February 22nd. Not only does it help to get to know your neighbors, it also increases the overall safety of neighborhoods.

Prior to the UNOE meeting, Mayor Terry hosted her first Traveling City Hall where members of the public were able to speak directly to the Mayor and members of her administration. In all, over 100 people were in attendance.

The Traveling City Hall will be held every 3 months at different locations throughout the city. Dates and locations will be announced in the UNOE newsletter and on the UNOE website www.unoevansville.org.

At the UNOE General Membership Meeting, the mayor spoke followed by Rodney Frye from the Evansville Fire Department who spoke about fire safety and education. Officer Matt Karges from the Evansville Police Department announced that several officers are being appointed to patrol city parks (*contact officer Karges at (812)-205-5113 for more information*) and the Vanderburgh County Sheriff Departments Lieutenant Chris Roe talked about the new Neighborhood Based Policing program. Shawn Dickerson with the Department of Urban Forestry reported on their wish to see trees planted in neighborhoods and mentioned the tree giveaway that was held on March 9th (*email Shawn at sdickerson@evansville.in.gov*)

Our next General Meeting will be on Thursday, March 28th, at the C.K. Newsome Community Center. Speaker, Karan Barnhill will talk about how grass clippings and yard debris can clog storm drains and cause flooding as well as problems with water quality. Representatives from the EPA will also make a presentation on lead clean up in neighborhoods.

Community Development Corp.

Missing Pieces Community Development Corporation is a 501 (c) 3 USDOT Nationwide Motor Carrier. We were founded to establish high priority programs within Evansville, Indiana, nationally, and worldwide. Our first priority is to preserve the safety of senior citizens, individuals with disabilities, low-income residents, and students. The recent opioid epidemic within our community as well as nationwide has increased crimes against our most vulnerable residents. We provide mass transit solutions that increase the mobility, quality of life, safety, and self-sufficiency for low-income residents. Our outreach programs reduce crime, provide access to quality healthcare, access to higher paying worksites, and also provides reliable transportation, through our execution of non-traditional programs.

Missing Pieces Projects are geared toward improving conflict resolution skills, self-image, self-worth, values, and the safety of our most vulnerable residents. In addition to our local programs, we provide emergency assistance to individuals in crisis and offer relief initiatives for low to moderate income (LMI) individuals. These individuals include but are not limited to the elderly, individuals with disabilities, homeless, veterans, displaced college students, previously addicted populations, and ex-offenders. It is our vision that Missing Pieces Project participants are provided emergency assistance which help them reach self-sufficiency. It is also our vision that every participant receives safe transport to their essential activities.

Our M.P.E.E. transportation service fills rapid rehire job postings. By providing reliable transportation, low-income populations are able to secure direct-hire, higher paying, full-time employment positions with benefits. Our collaborations assist participants with acquiring skills and job training to become self-sufficient. We do so through the use of tools that promote re-entering the workforce and our community. We seek to fill the void where much needed programs and emergency assistance do not exist. We, at Missing Pieces Community Development Corporation are "putting communities back together, one piece at a time."
