

1. Create an account.

Download the **METS Micro** app from the App Store or Google Play Store and follow the simple signup steps.

2. Book a ride.

Enter your pickup and dropoff addresses, choose the ride that works best for you, and tap **Book This Ride**.

3. Meet your driver.

Check the app to see where to meet your driver. The meetup spot might be a short walk from where you are, but your designated pickup point helps cut down on detours to get you to your destination faster! If you have mobility needs, add a note to your pickup so we can meet you at your door.


