SCAM ALERT

LAW ENFORCEMENT ⚠️ WARNING ⚠️

Has a "Sheriff's Deputy" called you about an unpaid fine or warrant?

Has a "US Marshal" called you and claimed you missed jury duty?

Has an "IRS Agent" called you about unpaid taxes?

Has a "Police Officer" called you about an unpaid traffic ticket?

Has a "Jail Officer" called you about bonding out a relative from jail?

BEFORE wiring money or purchasing pre-paid cards for money transfers, look for signs of fraud.

- Have you been contacted by someone you don't know or informed of winnings with an upfront fee?
- Received a call claiming to be with a government agency or others threatening action without immediate payment?
- Contacted about a family member or friend who is supposedly in trouble and needs immediate financial help?
- Entered into a new relationship where desperate stories and requests for money have been communicated?

These are all common **RED FLAGS** for scams. Be safe by:

- Calling local Law Enforcement directly to confirm what is being advised by the caller, they will be aware of recent scams.
- Attempting to contact friends or family members directly, verifying their identity by asking questions only they would know.
- If you cannot make contact, check with friends or family members who can verify their whereabouts or current situation.
- DO NOT rely on Caller ID as confirmation of identity. Caller ID can be easily "spoofed".

Once money has been transferred it is nearly impossible to trace!
