Historic Preservation Month

May is Historic Preservation Month! For our history and historic resources to survive, they need our constant support. This May there are a variety of special events planned featuring local history including walking tours, open houses, presentations, historic marker dedications, special events, and more.

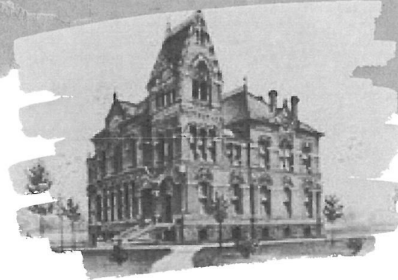
Historic Preservation Month is a great time to visit the local museums: the Evansville Museum, the Reitz Home Museum, the Evansville Wartime Museum, the Evansville African American Museum, the Peters-Margedant House, and USS LST-325. You can also visit and tour historic sites such as Oak Hill Cemetery, Angel Mounds State Park, the Old Courthouse, the Willard Library, Bosse Field, and the Victory Theatre.

This year features the walking tour "Here Lies Evansville" at Oak Hill Cemetery with tour guides former Historic Preservation Officer Dennis Au and the current officer, Timothy Miller. Other walking tours include Old Evansville, the Old Courthouse exterior, Lamasco, and "Let's Eat!," a tour of restaurants of the past. More tours include open houses at the Reitz House and the Peters-Margedant House, Free Day at the Evansville Museum, St. Boniface Catholic Church's Grotto, Angel Mounds' historic structures, and Bosse Field.

The Historic Preservation Month presentations include "Indiana Landmarks and its role in Historic Preservation in Southwest Indiana," John Wesley at Trinity United Methodist Church, "Civil Rights Movement in Evansville," "Local Histories," "Evansville's Role in World War II," "Hosting Derrick Lindow," and "Evansville Then and Now."

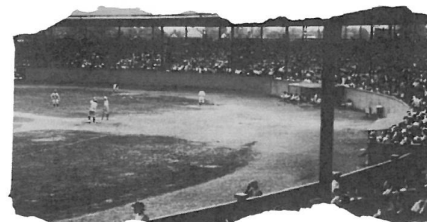
