RONALD McDONALD CARE MOBILE

Ensuring families remain close to each other and to the care they need.

The Ronald McDonald Care Mobile is a fully-equipped medical clinic on wheels that delivers free or reimbursed care to underserved women of child-bearing age, pregnant women, postpartum mothers, and infants up to 12 months in their neighborhoods.

According to the Vanderburgh County Health Department, fetal and infant mortality reflects the overall physical and mental health of a community.

Our primary objective is to deliver clinical care and supportive resources that promote key health outcomes:

- Breastfeeding through 12 months
- Healthy birth weights
- First-trimester prenatal care
- Safe sleep practices
- Maternal mental wellness

Because infant mortality rates are disproportionately higher among African American and Latino populations, removing barriers to care and education is essential to ensuring equitable access to healthier outcomes for all families.

This initiative represents the first collaborative program of its kind:

**Be Aware
of Bitcoin
ATM
Scams!**

HOW THE SCAM WORKS:

- ✓ A scammer calls or message you:
 - A government official (IRS, police, immigration)
 - A utility company (power, water, internet)
 - A tech support agent (Microsoft, Apple)
 - A romantic partner or online friend

- ✗ They create a sense of urgency:
 - "You owe money and will be arrested!"
 - "Your bank account is frozen!"
 - "Your power will be shut off!"
 - "I need help—send money now!"

↓ **Once sent, the money is GONE FOREVER.** No bank or police can get it back.

IMPORTANT TIPS:

- ✓ **NO** government agency or utility will ask you to pay with Bitcoin
- ✓ **Never** send Bitcoin to someone you haven't met in person
- ✓ **Don't** scan random QR codes at Bitcoin ATMs
