Thousands of neighborhoods across the nation are already using Nextdoor to build happier, safer places to call home.

People are using Nextdoor to: quickly get the word out about a break-in, organize a Neighborhood Watch Group, track down a trustworthy babysitter, find out who does the best paint job in town, ask for help keeping an eye out for a lost dog, find a new home for an outgrown bike, and finally call that nice man down the street by his first name. Nextdoor's mission is to use the power of technology to build stronger and safer neighborhoods.

Privacy on the net is always a huge issue for people, just as fences are sometimes necessary for your own yard. But online privacy is always necessary. Nextdoor makes it safe to share online the kinds of things you'd be okay sharing with your neighbors in person.

Here's how:

Every neighbor has to verify their address.

Every neighbor signs in with their real name. Just like in person.

Your website is protected by password and encrypted by HTTPS.

We never share your info with advertisers.
