ELIGIBLITY

To be eligible, a Neighborhood Association must:

- Have all **2019 Membership/Registration Forms** (including current By-Laws and Map supplied or confirmed as on file) submitted to the UNOE office by **Thursday, June 13, 2019**;
- Have **2019 Membership dues paid** by the above date unless the Neighborhood Association received a grant through attendance at the 2019 Sparkplug Recognition Banquet; and
- Submit the Yard Signs Project Order Form via email, mail or delivery to the UNOE office no later than 12:00noon on Thursday, June 27, 2019.

No funds will be needed at the time of the order. Neighborhoods will be invoiced after the orders are processed.

meeting and commented on how their children and/ or grandchildren routinely exchange books at the little library. The gal who built the little library was there as well! Her children were her inspiration."


